ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS IN PUBLIC PROCUREMENT AT FEDERAL LEVEL

Section 19(b) of the Public Procurement Act, 2007 gives Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) a role in the observance of Procurement Processes in Ministries, Departments and Agencies of the Federal Government.

To ensure that only credible organizations are involved in this observance, the Bureau is in the process of updating the profiles of non-governmental organizations engaged in public procurement, good governance, transparency and accountability.

Organizations interested in being so accredited are hereby requested to send the following information to the Bureau within two (2) weeks of this publication:

- i. Letter of intention to observe Procurement Processes in MDAs
- ii. Profile of the organization, including

its vision and mission; and the names, email addresses, phone numbers and curriculum vitae of the key officials.

- iii. Evidence of organization's registration with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC)
- iv. Details of the organization's work in public procurement, good governance, transparency and accountability

Organizations considered to have requisite capacity to strengthen the implementation of procurement reforms within the framework of the Act will be exposed to further training to enhance their capacity to observe the Procurement Processes in MDAs of Federal Government.
